
### **BACKGROUND/PURPOSE** PRTC Sand Filter and Sewer Ejector Pit Locations

1. How big is the sewer pit?	April 22, 2024/Magnolia Plumbing	The sewer ejector pit is approximately 20 feet in depth.
2. How often is maintenance done?	April 22, 2024/Magnolia Plumbing	The sewer ejector pit is serviced every quarter, the sand filters are cleaned and serviced annually per the existing contract.
3. Does line item #3 on Price Schedule (Attachment B) include cleaning and repairs?	April 22, 2024/Magnolia Plumbing	All services are specified in Section III.3.A.4, items a- d (pages 6-7) in the event an oil skim is discovered.
4. What are the hours that work can be done?	April 22, 2024/ Magnolia Plumbing	Work can be performed during normal operating business hours from 8:30am- 5:00pm and is not to interfere with daily business operations. Please contact Vince Walker, Facility Manager, to ask if an earlier time can be accommodated if needed.
5. Where are the locations for work vehicles to park while onsite?	April 22, 2024/Magnolia Plumbing	Work vehicles will have access to park within proximity of the sand pits and sewer ejector pits but should not impede the operations of buses coming in and out of the Transit Center or disrupt the flow of traffic within the employee parking lot.
6. Who is the current contractor?	April 22, 2024/Allgreen Landscape	The current contractor is HEPACO, LLC.
7. Why is a new contract needed?	April 22, 2024/ Allgreen Landscape	A new contract is needed because the existing contract is expiring soon on June 30, 2024.
8. How old is the current system?	April 22, 2024/Allgreen Landscape	The current system is 27 years old. (installed in 1997)

11. When was the last time the structures were serviced?	April 22, 2024/Muller, Inc.	The sand filters were last serviced in June 2023 and will be serviced again in June 2024. The sewer pits are serviced quarterly and were last serviced in February 2024.
